Theresa Freeman is a USF staff person in the Graduate Studies department. She was diagnosed with gastrointestinal cancer in 2013 and had surgery to remove it in 2014. Unfortunately, on August 17, 2015, she discovered that the cancer had returned. Theresa's husband, 14-year-old son and 5-year-old grandson all live with her. She is unable to work and has run out of sick leave and vacation leave. Her health insurance coverage will be canceled on October 31, 2015 because she is unable to work. During her first cancer surgery in 2014, staff was able to donate sick leave to her so that she could continue to receive a paycheck and health benefits. However, on January 1, 2015 the university changed its policies and USF will no longer allow fellow coworkers to donate sick leave to Theresa.
